

SB 677 (ORTIZ – 2003): VOTING HISTORY

HISTORY OF VOTES: The following is a brief timeline and explanation of SB 677 votes:

1. **Senate Education Committee - April 23, 2003:** The Education Committee passed the bill by a vote of 7 – 2. This version of the bill applied to all public schools K-12.
2. **Senate Floor – May 29, 2003:** The full Senate passed the bill by a vote of 22 – 15. This version of the bill applied to all public schools K-12.
3. **Assembly Health Committee – July 1, 2003:** The Health Committee amended the bill to exclude high schools, making beverage standards apply only in public elementary, middle and junior high schools. The Committee passed this version by a vote of 16 – 7.
4. **Assembly Education Committee – July 9, 2003:** The Education Committee passed the bill by a vote of 6 – 1. This version of the bill applied to public elementary, middle and junior high schools.
5. **Assembly Floor – August 21, 2003:** The full Assembly passed the bill by a vote of 42 – 32. This version of the bill applied to public elementary, middle and junior high schools.
6. **Senate Floor Concurrence – August 28, 2003:** The full Senate passed the bill again, by a vote of 22 – 14, approving the Assembly’s amendments to the bill. This version of the bill applied to public elementary, middle and junior high schools.
7. **Governor’s Signature – September 16, 2003:** The bill became law, and applies to all public elementary, middle and junior high schools, effective July 1, 2004.

VOTE NOTATIONS: Votes are recorded as either “Yes,” “No” or “No Vote Recorded”. The notation “No Vote Recorded” means either the Legislator was not present at the time of the vote or he/she abstained from voting.

COMMITTEE VOTES: Committee members’ votes are recorded as either “Yes,” “No” or “No Vote Recorded”. Legislators for whom there is no notation are not members of the Committee and therefore did not have a vote on the bill at that stage.
